

Directions

By car:

From M25 travelling anti-clockwise:

Leave M25 at the Godstone exit, follow signs towards Oxted and Westerham along the A25. At Limpsfield turn right where signposted to Edenbridge. Through Edenbridge Town, turn left at signpost to Hever Castle. A couple of miles along this road, turn right at signpost for Hever Station (immediately after the 'Welcome to Hever' sign). At the T-junction turn left and Hever Station is signposted at the second bend.

From M25 travelling clockwise:

Leave M25 at the Sevenoaks exit, follow signs for Hever Castle. When you have gone past the castle (on the left) follow the road on, past the Henry VIII pub. At the T-junction turn left and take the first turning on the right (signposted Hever Station, but unfortunately not clearly!). Follow this lane and Hever Station is well signposted to the left, on a sharp right-hand bend.

From Tunbridge Wells:

Follow A24 in direction of East Grinstead. Turn right at B2026 to Edenbridge. You will pass the Queen's Arms pub on your left - about half a mile further on, and just by a telephone box, turn (obliquely) right into a narrow lane called Hartfield Road. Follow this to T-junction. Turn left, go up the hill 150/200 yards or so and Hever Station is signposted on the left at the top of the hill.

By train:

From London Bridge:

Trains run from London Bridge every hour and the journey time is 46 minutes. Catch the train to Uckfield, which departs from London Bridge at seven minutes past the hour.

From Victoria:

Take the train from Victoria to East Grinstead and change at Oxted to pick up the London Bridge train.

Note: train times vary at rush hour times, so do check!

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
